DEEN DAYAL UPADHYAYA GRAMEEN KAUSHAL YOJANA (DDU-GKY) UNDER MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT, GOVT OF INDIA PROGRAMME:

Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) is a scheme under Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), Govt. of India and a part of the National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM), tasked with the dual objectives of adding diversity to the incomes of rural poor families and cater to the career aspirations of rural youth.

MFM is empanelled as a Project Implementing Agency (PIA) from 2019. Mission Foundation Movement (MFM) signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with MZSRLM on 7th March, 2019 for conducting General Duty. It focused on rural youth between the ages of 15 and 35 years from poor families. Assistant (Residential) with a target of 300 trainees at Aizawl District and a target of 100 Front Line Health Worker (FLHW) in Kolasib District for project duration of 3 years (36 months).

The project is funded by Ministry of Rural Development, Govt of India. For the out-going batches, Felicitation program was organised on 25th Sep 2019. Our activities during the financial year of 2019- 2020 are as follows:

PMVKY is a flagship scheme of the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) implemented by National Skill Development Corporation. The objective of this Skill Certification Scheme is to enable a large number of Indian youth to take up industry-relevant skill training that will help them in securing a better livelihood.

Community Development Programme (CDP)

Community Development Programme (CDP) has been launched from 2016 in collaboration with North East Rural Livelihood Projects (NERLP), Ministry of DoNER. The project covered 3 RD Blocks of Aizawl District i.e. Tlangnuam, Phullen and Aibawk RD Blocks. The objective of the project is to improve rural livelihood especially that of women, unemployed youth and disadvantage group of the society.

665 Self Help Group (SHG's), 40 Community Development Group (CDG) and 40 Federation have been established in 40 villages of 3 RD Block of Aizawl District. With this programme the people benefitted enormously in the field of agriculture, farming and animal husbandry. The ultimate goal is to create self employment in Piggery, Poultry, Tailoring, Petty Trade etc.





Working Women Hostel

With the progressive change in the socio-economic fabric of the country, more and more women are leaving their homes in search of employment in big cities as well as urban and rural industrial clusters. One of the main difficulties faced by such women is lack of safe and conveniently located accommodation.

Realizing this need, a Working Women Hostel for 100 working women and Day Care Centre for 30 children under the Centrally sponsored umbrella scheme, Mission for Protection and Empowerment under Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt of India. has been constructed at Durtlang, Gosen veng, Aizawl.

The site preparation and earth work started from April, 2019. The foundation works, basement 1, basement 2, ground floor and upto second floor were completed within the reported period i.e 2019- 2020. The Construction works of the building is to be completed within 24 months from the date of sanction of the first installment as per sanctioning letter issued by the Ministry.



MFM School of Nursing (ANM)

MFM School of Nursing was established in the year 2009 with approval from the Indian Nursing Council and Mizoram Nursing Council with an intake capacity of 20 seats per batch. The duration of Training is 2 years.

Currently we have 23 students in the 9th batch and 20 students in 10th batche respectively during the Financial year of April, 2019 to March, 2020.

Rural Posting of students of ANM with their tutors as routine has been held during 09.05.2019 to 02.06.2019 at Khamrang Village and its hamlets and they camped at the premises of the 10 Bedded Hospital established by our organisations in 2016.

As routine, outdoor activities like World Diabetes day, World Cancer day, Nurses Day etc. were performed and practical field visits by students were conducted to Orphanage Homes, Old aged Home, Remand Home etc. during the reported year.





LAITHANGPUII COLLEGE OF PHARMACY

Pharmacists play a vital role in the health care system in dispensing medicines and providing latest information on various drugs. The Laithangpuii College of Pharmacy (LCP) is one of the units of the MFM established in 2013 with an intake capacity of 60 students per session. The College offers a two year Diploma in Pharmacy.

This year we have a total of 85 students; 41 from the 6th Batch (1st Year Students) and 44 from the 5th Batch (2nd Year Students). Our academic session is started in the month of August every year. A graduation day is held for 44 finalstudents of 4th Batch at Tourist Lodge, Chaltlang on 5th February, 2020 and Orientation for fresh students of 6th batch held at the College Hall on 3rd Sept, 2019.

10 BEDDED HOSPITAL AT KHAMRANG, KOLASIB DISTRICT

Many villages in Mizoram do not have basic health care facilities which create a dire need of health workers, nurses and doctors in rural areas. Recognizing this need, MFM opened a Health Clinic at Khamrang Village in 2012, with the approval from the Health Department, Govt. of Mizoram, covering five The Hospital covered 6 villagesnamely Khamrang, New Khamrang, Mualkhang, West Serzawl, Nazareth and Gas Bottling Plant Complex.

In 2015 a new building was funded by the Embassy of Japan in New Delhi. It was inaugurated by Mr Akio Isomata Economic Minister, Embassy of Japan and Chief Minister of Mizoram on 4th of April 2016. Maintenance of the clinic is funded by Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt. of India.

In 2017, we upgraded it to 10 Bedded facility and a fund amounting to Rs 12, 48,300 was received from the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt. Of India. We now have adequate staffs which enable us to conduct health awareness campaigns, rendering health services, health teachings, environment and sanitation awareness programmes to our target communities.

START UP VILLAGE ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAM (SVEP)

Start up Village Entrepreneurship Program (SVEP) is a sub component of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) of the Ministry of Rural Development. SVEP aims to support entrepreneurs in rural areas to set up local enterprises.

It strives to help the rural poor come out of poverty by helping them set up enterprises and provide support till the enterprises stabilize. The programmatic intervention addresses all three missing ecosystems – Knowledge, advisory and finance ecosystems.

As an empanelled Project Implementing Agency (PIA), we started implementing it from 2019. At present we covered the whole district of Kolasib with as many as 1000 Target beneficiaries.





MOBILE DISPENSARY/ MULTI-SERVICE MOBILE UNIT AT MAMIT, MAMIT DIATRICT

Under the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, MFM received a Grant-in aid to run Mobile Dispensary at Mamit District which is an aspirational district driven by the necessity to make health care facilities more accessible and affordable. As an Aspirational district, the community needs a great deal of extra attention to enhance the welfare of the tribal's residing in this area.

This scheme helps in providing environment for socioeconomic upliftment and overall development of the Scheduled Tribes (STs). Presently, there are 15 no of volunteers and doctors working to make health care morehandy and accessible.



HEALTH CLINIC AT GOJALGHAT, ASSAM

A health clinic was organized by MFM at Ghozalghat village, Cachar district, Assam, located near the Asam-Mizoram inter-state boundary. Currently we have one Health Worker with helper posted there. Health care facilities are basically not available in these areas and our clinic has proven to be very beneficial to these communities.
