MoU signed with KOBE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

24th November, 2023

MFM and Kobe International University, JICA, Social welfare Houonkai Japan signed a MOU on 24th November, 2023 at Kobe that will enable Nurses from Mizoram to work in Japan.

Kobe International University will provide further training at Japan for Nurses once they arrived.

Under this agreement, Nurses from Mizoram will have the opportunity to work as Geriatric Caregivers in Japan. A six months Japanese language course is introduced at MFM School of Nursing at Aizawl and Students who passed this course will receive free flight ticket and accommodation at Japan. The agreement was signed by Rev. Basil Sataru Yashiro, Chairman, Board of Trustee, Prof Shigenori Vice President, Kobe International University, MFM Director R Vanlalauva and MFM School of Nursing Principal, Christina Zothanpuii Principal. MFM team arrived back to Mizoram on 5th December.



CHOW CHOW SURVEY AT SIHPHIR WITH LOCAL FARMERS

24th November, 2023



MFM staffs and Chow Chow growers association conducted survey and data collection at Sihphir on 24th November, 2023 with experts from the Department of Agriculture.

The Chow Chow growers association has not been able to get a good yield from their crops in the past few years. The main problem being bacteria infections, lack of fertilizers and soil degradation. Survey and collection of samples will help identify problems and reveal areas to concentrate on for further activities.

The project 'CHOW-CHOW GROWING for SUSTAINABLE FARMING' is designed to help squash farmers at the region to have a more productive harvest with a more-friendly approach.

Soil and paste samples are collected for further studies. Project Coordinator Mr. HL Rinawma and Miss Esther Lalthachawii accompanied the survey from MFM. The project covers Durtlang, Sihphir and Lungdai with headquarters at Sihphir.

Start Up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP) Project end Meeting

Start Up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP) project end meeting was held at Aijal Club on 22nd November. The meeting was attended by HL Rinawma and Jacob Lalrinawma from MFM. 3rd November 2023,

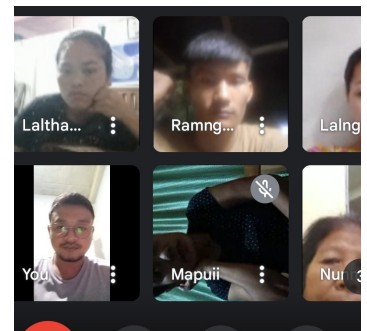

Success Story - C Lalneihthangi

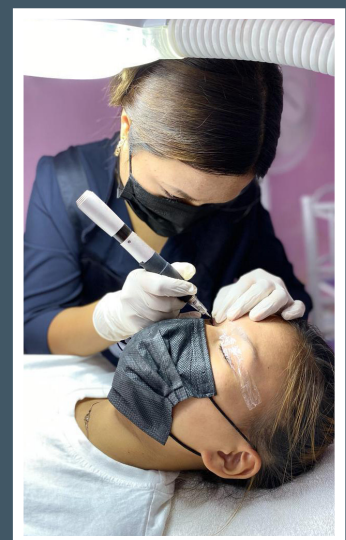
