TRAINING FOR FY 2024-2025 STARTED

The JSS Mamit has organized its training schedule into three quarters. The first quarter encompasses the months of July through September. For this quarter, training programs commenced in August and are focused on four key job roles: Beauty Care Assistant, Assistant Dress Maker, Food Processing, Assistant Computer Operator and Two/Three-Wheeler Mechanic. Total number of 180 students of various trades started their training in the month of August.



These training programs are designed to equip participants with essential skills and knowledge in their respective fields. The Beauty Care Assistant training includes modules on skincare, haircare, and cosmetic application techniques. The Assistant Dress Maker program covers sewing, pattern-making, and garment alteration skills. Food Processing training provides insights into food safety, preservation techniques, and quality control. Lastly, the Two/Three-Wheeler Mechanic course fo-

cuses on repair, maintenance, and troubleshooting of motorcycles and scooters.

Each program aims to enhance employability and provide practical experience to ensure that participants are well-prepared for the job market.

ENROLMENT DRIVE AND CERTIFICATION CONDUCTED

On August 2, 2024, the Programme Officer, Assistant Programme Officer, Field Assistant, and Driver visited West Phaileng, Rawpuichhip, and Khawrihnim.
