## Jan Shikshan Sansthan, Mamit Activity Report (May 2023)

Online Meeting and Action Plan: Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) participated in an online meeting to discuss the creation of the action plan for the financial year 2023-2024. The team successfully developed an action plan targeting 1800 beneficiaries across 15 job roles. The plan is currently awaiting approval from the Central Ministry.

Director Transition: Miss Lavenzuali, the former Director of JSS, resigned from her position. On May 18, 2023, Miss Lalrinfeli officially joined as the new Director of JSS.

Skill Assessment - Backyard Poultry Farming: The SHL Team conducted a skill assessment for the job role of Backyard Poultry Farming, which is categorized under the agriculture sector. This assessment was conducted on May 23, 2023, as part of the PMKVY 4.0 (Skill Hub Initiative Programme).

Training Collaboration - Baking Technician: JSS collaborated with Mission Foundation Movement and UD&PA to provide training for the job role of Baking Technician under the DaY-NULM program. The training session was conducted on May 30, 2023.

Field Training and Study: JSS provided on-field training to youth from the Baptist Church of Mizoram and United Church of God for the job role of Pickle Making Technician. Additionally, the trainers of Electrical Technician (PMKVY 4.0) organized a field study for their students to enhance their practical knowledge.

Assessment of Job Roles: JSS conducted assessments for three batches of Beauty Care Assistant, one batch of Welder and Fabricator, and one batch of Two/Three Wheeler Mechanic, as part of JSS Action Plan B. These assessments aimed to evaluate the skills and progress of the trainees.

Enrollment and Monitoring: Throughout the month, JSS focused on enrollment and monitoring activities to ensure the effective implementation of its programs. This included tracking participant enrollments, monitoring program quality, and addressing any issues that arose.

In summary, Jan Shikshan Sansthan's activities in May involved an online meeting to develop the action plan, a director transition, skill assessments, training collaborations, field training, job role assessments, and enrollment and monitoring efforts. These initiatives aimed to provide skill development opportunities and empower individuals across various job roles.
